LIMITED WARRANTY INFORMATION

Subject to the following limitations, terms and conditions, Reynolds Cycling ("Reynolds") warrants to the original retail purchaser that each Reynolds bicycle component purchased when new is free from defects in material and workmanship. This warranty expires two (2) years from the date of original purchase of the Reynolds bicycle component from an authorized Reynolds dealer.

THIS WARRANTY DOES NOT COVER:

1. Normal wear-and-tear.
2. Any damage, failure or loss caused by accident, misuse, neglect, abuse, failure to follow instructions or warnings in assembly instructions.
3. Any damage, failure or loss caused by use of bicycles for stunt riding, ramp jumping, acrobatics, or other similar activities, or in any manner other than normal cycling.
4. Any damage, failure, or loss caused by the use of bicycles not intended for such use, as power driven vehicles.
5. The original owner shall pay all labor connected with the repair or replacement of all parts. Under no circumstance does the limited warranty include the cost of shipment or transportation to or from Reynolds or an authorized Reynolds dealer.

WARRANTY PROCEDURES

- All returning product requires a Return Merchant Authorization (RMA) number issued by Reynolds Cycling prior to being returned. To receive an RMA, you will need to complete the warranty claim registration form located on our website at www.reynoldscycling.com/warranty. If you do not have access to a computer please call 801-565-8003.
- Warranty service will be performed by Reynolds or a Reynolds authorized dealer.
- Proof of purchase **MUST** be provided. Transportation to and from Reynolds or a Reynolds authorized dealer is the responsibility of the purchaser.
- Reynolds will have the option of either repair or replacement at no charge for the defective product, or repayment of an amount equal to the purchase price of the product.
- If you elect to repair a defective product yourself or use the services of someone other than a Reynolds authorized dealer, or if you use a replacement part not supplied by Reynolds, Reynolds will not be liable for any damage, failure or loss caused by the use of such unauthorized service or parts.

LIMITATIONS

Proof of purchase from an authorized Reynolds dealer is required for any limited warranty replacement or repair.

ATTACHMENT OF QUICK RELEASE WHEEL TO FORK AND FRAME

Proper operation of the quick release is essential to safe riding. Check the quick release before every ride, and make sure it is properly secure, if it is not properly secured the wheel may wobble or disengage from the bicycle, which may result in serious bodily injury or death. If you do not fully understand its operation, see your authorized Reynolds dealer.

Reynolds Carbon wheels with the CTg braking system are equipped with Reynolds Cryo-Blue brake pads which are an integral part of the CTg braking system. We only recommend the use of these brake pads. Use of any other brake pads will immediately void your warranty and/or Reynolds Assurance claim. (Alloy, Disc Brake and MTN Carbon wheels do not apply.)
